2023 World Day of Prayer preparations are underway. If you have received the pack of resources but are not going to be involved in leading the service, please send it on to someone who is. Please try to contact every church in your area so we can make this a really ecumenical service. Although the service is written by women, with women's stories, men are always welcome.

Services in 2022 were disrupted by the Covid 19 pandemic resulting in changes in venues and dates, as well as some groups being unable to meet at all. Some groups and individuals joined a service online. The National Committee was impressed with the creative efforts that many groups made to join services. Thank you so much for your continued support.

In June I was privileged to represent Aotearoa New Zealand at an international meeting hosted by Scotland WDP and held online. The events began at 9 am New York time (1 am in New Zealand!). During this meeting, Joyce Steiner from Ghana was elected International Chairperson. Joyce is the first African woman to be elected to this international position. The new Executive Director is Katie Reimer from New York. Pacific Region delegates to the International Committee are Vicki Marney from Australia and Amanda Sanele Josefo from Samoa.
